INPACE focuses on the establishment of a sustainable multi-stakeholder Indo-Pacific European Hub for digital technology collaboration. Its main goal is to aid the implementation of Digital Partnerships with Japan, the Republic of Korea, and Singapore, along with cooperation with India within the Trade and Technology Council framework.

The INPACE Hub seeks to create a lasting expert-driven mechanism for EU-Indo-Pacific collaboration – the INPACE Community – comprising experts in the Thematic Working Groups and the broader community of INPACE stakeholders. The INPACE Community Platform serves as the central hub for their collaboration and knowledge sharing.



Thematic working groups and clusters

INPACE organises exchanges through Thematic Working Groups that bring together experts from industry, associations, government institutions and the research communities from the partner countries and Europe.

The mission of these Thematic Working Groups is to analyse the research policies and the needs of the partner countries.

4. **Cluster 4:** Digital Technologies: Chips for the Future
5. **Cluster 5:** Digital Technologies: Future Networks

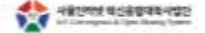
